
Lesson 38 - Joshua's Last Charge to Obey God

Color Joshua's robes. Joshua set up a big stone as a witness between them that they agreed not to worship the idols that the other people were worshipping, but had agreed to obey God. Talk with the children about each of the items below, and explain to them that there were people who actually worshipped those things. Encourage the children to talk about how silly it is to think that these things have any power and to worship them. See page 165 for additional pieces needed to complete this activity. When the children are finished, all the idols will be covered up and the big stone will say GOD.

Cut out the big "stone" below, then cut along the dotted red lines. Children will glue-stick these pieces to the big "stone" on page 90 to cover up all those things that the people may be worshipping. When they finish, all the idols will be covered up, and only GOD will be visible.
