

Lesson 40 - Gideon Won Without Fighting

Color Gideon's clothes and his fleece. See page 169 for additional pieces needed for this activity. Children can insert the torch into the pitcher when Gideon and his men go to battle, then remove it when Gideon tells his men to break their pitchers. Also give each child a paper cup with a hole in the bottom so they can use it like a trumpet. As they review the story, they will pull out the torch, wave it in the air, and blow their "trumpets."

Cut out the pitcher and torch below. Allow the children to tape the pitcher directly in front of the pitcher on page 96, leaving the top open, making a pocket in which to insert the torch. As the children review the story, they can insert the torch into the pitcher when Gideon goes to battle, then remove it when Gideon tells all his men to break their pitchers.
